After tiling remember to use **Dunlop Coloured Silicone** in corners and in junctions with other backgrounds, for example between worktops and walls, around the sink etc, as shown by the yellow key.

Ceramic tiles are ideal for kitchen floors; hygienic, easy to clean and durable. They are the perfect permanent solution. Pick up our floors leaflet for more information.



Walls should be flat, clean, dry and in a firm, sound condition. Note that typical background surfaces, such as plaster or plasterboard are water sensitive. If the plaster has a dusty appearance, wipe it down with a damp cloth and prime with **Dunlop Primer and Additive**. Emulsion painted walls should be deeply scored prior to tiling.



For walls, use **Dunlop Wall Tile Adhesive**, a non-slip ready-mixed adhesive.

Any surface which may be in contact with food needs to be impervious, non-toxic, hygienic and easy to clean.

On timber surfaces and non-porous backgrounds use **Dunlop Wall & Floor Tile Adhesive**, together with **Dunlop Coloured Grout** mixed with **Dunlop Primer & Additive**.
